### Numbers:


Look at the pirates counting and see if it is right - treasure, or wrong - trash! Help the pirates with their counting! They have counted out coins on the back of their treasure maps.




### Telescopes!


Take a kitchen roll (or loo roll) to use as a telescope. Talk about how to make patterns looking at colour and shape. This could be with paints or with tape you have around the house.


